- 3) Must provide a biographical statement and photograph to be displayed publicly

Nominating Process and Timeline

Step 1	Nominee names and information submitted <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide nominee’s name, phone, mailing address and email address • Provide brief statement as it relates to the nominees work with scholarship, cultural arts or community enrichment. • Provide confirmation that the candidate will be able to BE PRESENT at the event (Fri. Nov 3rd)
Step 2	List of nominees sent to TOWF Board
Step 3	Board votes
Step 4	Voting results emailed to Board
Step 5	Confirmation of honoree’s acceptance by Nominator <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominator to send email to bcousin5@aol.com to document that Nominee accepts and will attend the event.
Step 6	Formal letters mailed to the confirmed honorees <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include signed release of image for marketing purposes • Honoree provides biographical statement and photograph
